



Vocational Graduate Diploma of Ministry

[NRT 51957; CRICOS 062947B]*



A **one-year (full-time) course** (32 cps) providing further vocational competencies for ministry in a range of areas, including pastoral ministry, youth and children's ministries, chaplaincies and cross-cultural workers. The graduate will have a detailed knowledge of the Christian faith and will be able to apply it to a significant extent in an extensive range of ministry areas.

The course has flexibility to enable fulfillment of competency requirements of different denominational accrediting bodies and may be taken either full or part-time.

Entry Requirement:

Evidence of competency equivalent to an Advanced Diploma in a Christian theological discipline (commonly after a three year program, which may also be met by completion of a BMin, BTh or MDiv degree).

Structure of course:

8 units (each 4 cps) comprising:

Research unit completed at 600-level (WA0145++650V)

7 elective units selected from the general unit list*, all to be completed at 300 level or above
