These courses are designed to enable students to gain necessary competencies to be effective in a range of ministry contexts, including lay ministry workers in churches, religious education teachers, children and youth ministry workers, pastors, cross cultural workers and chaplains. They are deliberately flexible, providing a core foundation of biblical and theological units, with a wide range of biblical, theological and ministry units so that students may select units that fit specific growth and ministry goals.

Structure of courses

The courses are divided into units (each of 4 cps) [see separate information sheet for list of units*]. Each course may be taken full or part-time.

Certificate IV in Ministry:

1 year full-time (2 semesters, each of 13 weeks), consisting of 8 units:
3 core units (at least one unit from each of the groups in the Core Unit list)
5 elective units from any level

Diploma of Ministry

2 years full-time (4 semesters, each of 13 weeks), consisting of 16 units
3 core units (at least one unit from each of the groups in the Core Unit list)
13 elective units, no more than 8 at 100 level, with the balance at 300 level or above

Advanced Diploma of Ministry

3 years full-time (6 semesters, each of 13 weeks), consisting of 16 units
3 core units (at least one unit from each of the groups in the Core Unit list)
21 elective units, no more than 8 at 100 level, with the balance at 300 level or above
