

A **one year program** (max 4yrs part-time) for persons who are graduates in a non-theological discipline**, with a balance of 8 core and elective units that allow for variety of interests and study goals. [*This can be the first year of the Master of Divinity.] There are no prerequisites governing selection of units.

- From Israel to Judea (from 8th century prophets, to post-exilic literature)
- The Content and Setting of the Gospel Tradition
